Prevent Tick Diseases!

Ticks are common parasites that can be found anywhere, from woods to urban parks. They wait and then lunge onto passersby.



Ticks can transmit Lyme disease, Ehrlichiosis and Anaplasmosis. They can also cause anemia and other problems.



Because Rochester's weather is so unpredictable, year-round parasite prevention is recommended.

In **New York state** in 2013, **1 out of 10 dogs** tested positive for Lyme disease and **1 out of 20 dogs** tested positive for Anaplasmosis.

In **Monroe County**, the number of dogs who tested positive for Lyme disease **more than doubled** from 2011 to 2013.
